As we head into August **we are excited to offer our first in-person worship services since mid-March this coming Sunday, August 9 at 9:30am!**

What another terrific blessing during this time, allowing us a way to gather comfortably and safely!

Members and guests now can have their spiritual needs met in a variety of ways, while holding the words from Galatians and Christ's commandment to love one another in our hearts. Please know, **no one is required or expected to attend in-person gatherings and no one will be judged for either choice of worship participation.** Everyone's safety and personal comfort level are highly valued. No matter the choice please respect the prayerful decisions your siblings in Christ are making during this season.

The attached plan, effective as of today, was assembled by the HOPE Resuming Worship Task Force, Worship Ministry, and Executive Ministry teams in consultation with our local county health departments and the ELCA, following CDC guidelines. Due to expected changing circumstances, we will be reviewing our procedures regularly and will remove or replace restrictions as appropriate. We recognize that some of these protocols are quite restrictive. The reality is there are differences of opinion on these protocols among us. In the spirit of our faith we hope that, by beginning with an abundance of caution we will be able to safely move forward in coming months. We appreciate your grace, flexibility, and prayers as we continue to navigate being the Church in this season.
