

#### **Northwest Synod of Wisconsin 2023 Assembly**

On April 29th Keith Getschel and Denise Burkett served as HOPE's 2023 Synod Assembly voting members. We are so grateful they were both willing to take the time to serve in this capacity! The NWSWI is comprised of 199 congregations in the northwest portion of WI. We are 1 of 65 synods across the greater ELCA. Every year, 2 representatives of each congregation, plus rostered leaders and specialized ministry representatives assemble to faithfully conduct the business of the Synod. This year's assembly gathered around the theme "Rebound: From Worry to Wonder" as we explored Jesus' words in Matthew 6:25-34,"Do not worry.....but seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness...

The word "synod" may be new to you! A synod in the ELCA is a group of congregations and specialized ministries in a specific area of a state or region. Together we all are the synod. Without faithful people gathering in congregations, there would be no synod. Similar to each congregation having rostered and lay leadership, each synod also has its own rostered leadership, typically composed of a Synod Bishop, Assistants to the Bishop, and a Director of Evangelical Mission as well as lay leadership, including a synod VP and a council made up of representative from each conference of our synod. They nurture the work of our congregations and serve as a bridge to the greater Churchwide expression of the ELCA.

The Churchwide (greater ELCA) organization leads the church on a national and global level, and is responsible for things like Lutheran World Relief, The Youth Gathering, Young Adults in Global Mission, and a lot more. It too has its own rostered and lay leadership. While you may sometimes hear people say "the synod makes us" or "churchwide made us"...that is not how the structure of our Church works. Decisions are only made at a synodical or churchwide level when representatives of all the congregations and synods vote to make such decisions. In that respect, we are the ELCA.

At this year's Synod Assembly, all seven resolutions were passed. Half of these resolutions take place each year (synod budget, compensation guidelines, and other organizational details). The other 4 were a Constitutional Amendment on the Bishop's Election to allow for background checks on nominees, A Land Acknowledgment Resolution, A Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Vision Statement, and a Campus Ministry resolution. 




