Announcement of Congregational Meeting June 4, 2023

Dear HOPE Family,

Please plan to attend a Congregational Meeting at 10:45AM on Sunday, June 4, 2023.

HOPE Lutheran received an insurance check in 2022 for replacement of the metal roof on the Winds of the Spirit building in the amount of \$30,983.34 which was deposited into our account.

The Property ministry sought bids for replacement, receiving two. One was in the amount of \$11,100 and the second was in the amount of \$22,400. No other bids were received. HOPE Ministry Council requested a third bid at the April, 2023 meeting. Property Ministry team members are still actively seeking a third bid to present at the congregational meeting. Property Ministry also checked into the cost of materials to replace the roof which they feel had cosmetic damage. Material costs were about \$1100.

Property Ministry recommendations to the Council for the May meeting were as follows:

- \Rightarrow Do not replace the WOTS roof
- \Rightarrow Pay off the WOTS loan (\$17,018)
- ⇒ Place the remaining balance (\$13,965) in the Capital Improvement Fund to be used on future major improvement projects (such as the roof project)

Rational for these recommendations included:

- \Rightarrow replacement costs were small
- \Rightarrow The settlement funds could be used to pay off the WOTS loan
- ⇒ The settlement funds could be used to purchase additional sanctuary chairs, maintain the parking lot, purchase a church building humidifier or replace the older asphalt roof, use for construction of a columbarium, or replace the roof if needed in the future.

The church council discussed these options thoroughly to make a decision without a majority in agreement with Property's proposal. Due to the fact that the dollar amount is over \$5,000, our constitution requires a vote by members of the congregation. Please make every effort to weigh in on this decision June 4, 2023, at 10:45 am after the worship service. Property ministry members will be there to answer questions.


