Annual Meeting Follow-Up

Thank you to all who attended our 2024 annual meeting either online or in person. The potluck was delicious and it was a joy to celebrate our ministry together. You are welcome to view the <u>detailed presentation HERE</u>, but here are some key highlights from the meeting:

- 1. 2023 general offering income highest we've had, but short of budget goal by about \$4400. Mortgage income about \$7400 less than budgeted goal. Overall, expenses exceeded income by about \$5600 and this deficit has been covered from our cash reserves.


FOR OUR WINTER SESSION OF WOH!


